Walking with dinosaurs - reconstructing behaviour in extinct animals *Dr Greq Funston*

Greg has done field-work in several continents and at present is a Royal Society International Fellow at Edinburgh University in the School of GeoSciences.

The interactions between animals and their environments is a crucial force in natural selection and evolution. But how can we understand the behaviours of extinct animals without directly observing them? In this talk, Dr. Funston will take you into the world of dinosaur behaviour, explaining what evidence is left behind and what it tells us about the ways in which extinct animals lived. In particular, it will focus on social behaviour in dinosaurs, and how new finds are helping to shatter the image of dinosaurs as violent, solitary animals.
